

It is the expectation of the Mid Island Performing Arts Festival committee that all participants, teachers and parents afford all Festival volunteers, adjudicators, participants and teachers due courtesy and respect.

Verbal abuse or harassment of any nature will not be tolerated and may result in DISQUALIFICATION OF THE PARTICIPANT(S) involved and exclusion from all Festival venues.

Note to Competitors and Concert Performers

APPRECIATION: The Mid Island Performing Arts Festival greatly appreciates the support and cooperation of all those who help make the festival an outstanding event in the community's cultural life. We are particularly grateful for all our volunteers because the Festival could not operate without them. Thank you to the music stores, studios, teachers, and businesses that support our Festival.

Please note the requirements for dress for Music/Speech performers – no jeans, please:

Girls/Women: Appropriate concert attire (dress, skirt/dress slacks with blouse)

Boys/Men: Appropriate concert attire (suit or jacket, dress slacks and shirt)

Dance competitors should wear age- and genre-appropriate dancewear and costumes.

ADJUDICATION

The Adjudicator's decision is final in matters of adjudication and selection of class winners. The Adjudicator is NOT compelled to select a Provincial Representative in each section.

COMMUNICATION WITH ADJUDICATORS ON THE PART OF THE COMPETITORS, TEACHERS OR PARENTS, EXCEPT THROUGH THE MIPAF COMMITTEE, IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

Complaints or protests should be made in writing to the Festival Secretary (NOT the Adjudicator), accompanied by a protest fee of **\$25.00**. The fee will be returned in full should the protest be sustained. The Protest Committee will comprise a maximum of five Festival Committee members, whose decision will be final.

REHEARSALS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE PERFORMING AREAS DURING THE DATES OF THE MID ISLAND PERFORMING ARTS FESTIVAL. AREAS DESIGNATED FOR WARM-UP MAY BE AVAILABLE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SECTION CHAIRPERSON.

THE USE OF CAMERAS, VIDEO CAMERAS, TAPE OR RECORDERS OF ANY TYPE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN VENUES DURING THE SESSIONS AND ANY PERFORMANCES SPONSORED BY THE MID ISLAND PERFORMING ARTS FESTIVAL.

This does not include authorized members of the media.

IMPORTANT

EFFECT OF BILL 1985 C-42 – COPYRIGHT ACT

It is illegal to copy previously published material by any means. Publishers usually hold the copyright, and, in the case of firms no longer in business, their copyrights are transferred as assets to others. A letter is required from any publisher who has permitted the copying of their work. Internet copies are acceptable only with a valid receipt. The use of photocopies for page turns, etc., must respect the fair dealing provisions of the Act, which include educational purposes. This does not mean that an adjudicator has the original sheet music and the performer has a photocopy; two purchased copies must be present at the competition venue. Heavy penalties are enacted in this legislation and have been levied upon other arts organizations. The Society cannot afford to be compromised and has a 'no-tolerance' policy against copyright infringement.

Liz Tookey



From a very young age, Liz knew she needed dance to be a part of her life.

Her career has allowed her to experience a wide scope of what the industry has to offer.

She started performing with Princess Cruises, travelled to Tokyo, Japan, where she was part of the featured pas de deux couple in “Encore!” at Tokyo Disney Sea, and also to Egypt and Israel performing in a show tour for the Canadian military.

Liz was able to exercise all of her skills in dancing, acting and singing when the love of the stage drew her to the world of musical theatre. Throughout her career, she got to play a wide variety of characters. In Theatre Calgary’s production of “Anne of Green Gables”, The Arts Club production of “Spamalot”, and a dream come true performance in the North American Premiere / Toronto Mirvish production of “Dirty Dancing”, she performed as ensemble and 1st “Baby” understudy.

Liz can be seen on various episodes of the CW Network’s “Hellcats” as a featured dancer and as Ashley Tisdale’s dance double, as Maggie Lawson’s dance double in the musical episode of “Psych”, a featured dancer in ABC’s “Once Upon a Time”, Nickelodeon’s “Jinxed”, “The Layover”, NBC’s “Zoey’s Extraordinary Playlist” and Paramount’s “Rise Of The Pink Ladies”.

Transitioning to the world of choreography, Liz began by assisting choreographers on “So You Think You Can Dance Canada”. She was also part of the creative team for ‘Reefer Madness’. Liz’s choreography can be seen on Super Channel’s “When Calls the Heart” and ABC’s “Once Upon a Time”. She was the personal dance coach for award-winning actor Domhnall Gleeson for the feature film “Crash Pad”, and most recently directed the opening and closing numbers for Air Canada Vacations’ national corporate tour.

Liz loves to share her passion for what she does with pre-professional and professional dancers across North America via master classes, adjudicating and choreography.

Ballet & Modern Adjudicator

Geraldine Potter



Geraldine Potter began her dance journey at the Royal Winnipeg Ballet's Professional Division, graduating in 1991. Her performing career took her across the globe – from the Royal Winnipeg Ballet to Geneva Ballet Theatre, Hanover Ballet, and several companies throughout France, including Dance á Lille, Les Ballet Classique, and Crasto. During these years, she danced in works by Nacho Duato, Maurice Béjart, Renée Mencini, and Marlies Delante – choreographers whose vision would deeply influence her own creative path.

When she stepped off stage, choreography called. She created her first piece for two students at the Royal Winnipeg Ballet, entering it in the company's Fast Forward competition, where it won the Patti Stone Award for Best Choreography. That same work, *Liberte*, was later performed at Ballet in the Park in Winnipeg and in Japan. This early success led her to found Fresh Feet Productions in Vancouver, where she served as Artistic Director, creating workshops at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre that brought together professional dancers from Ballet BC, the Royal Winnipeg Ballet, and companies across Canada. Moving to France, she continued developing her choreographic voice, mounting pieces and full productions for various companies throughout the region.

Teaching became equally central to her artistic life. She completed both the Royal Winnipeg Ballet School's Professional Division Teacher's Certificate and France's rigorous National State Teaching Certificate. Over the years, she taught students across Europe and Canada, adjudicated festivals, including the BC Festival of the Performing Arts, led masterclasses internationally, and taught summer intensives at professional schools, including the Edmonton School of Ballet, the Royal Winnipeg Ballet School, and Les Ballets du Nord. In 2006, she co-founded The Nanaimo Ballet School, serving as Co-Director until 2010, and remained a sought-after private coach until she retired from dance to pursue graduate studies in psychology.

Today, Geraldine is a Registered Clinical Counsellor with the BC Association of Clinical Counsellors and runs her own practice, Konekt Counselling Services. Her client work often brings her full circle – working with dancers navigating performance anxiety, disordered eating, and perfectionism, struggles she understands from both sides of the mirror.

She's delighted to return to the dance stage as adjudicator, bringing not just her eye for artistry but decades of pedagogical insight to support young dancers in their technical and creative development.






